



## element high school ministry student leadership team

Element High School Ministry 2010-2011

Anyone interested in serving on the student leadership team must meet the following guidelines, which were drawn primarily from the leadership requirements found in 1 Timothy 3:1-5.

### **Spiritual Requirements:**

- Must be a consistent, although not perfect Christian. Anyone with a reputation of living a double life is not eligible to serve.
- Must have a servant attitude.
- Must honor God in relationships with the opposite sex (language, dress, and purity).
- Must continually strive to be in the Word of God every day.
- Must not drink alcohol or use illegal drugs.
- Must be a uniter, not a divider.
- Must not be consumed by materialism (putting worldly possessions before God).
- Must handle family relationships in a God-honoring way.
- Must not be an immature Christian (in terms of length of time and spiritual maturity).
- Must be willing to step outside of the comfort zone.
- Must have a good reputation with outsiders.

### **Team Expectations:**

- Must attend an SCC main worship service on a regular basis.
- Must be actively serving in a ministry on a consistent basis, outside of student leadership. (examples: Element greeting team, SCC Kids small group leader, etc.)
- Must be a committed member of an Element Small Group.
- Must consistently attend Element service (outreach time where much of the student leadership will happen).
- Must attend regular student leadership meetings, which will be twice per month— usually Sundays at lunch. Missing two meetings without an excuse means removal from the team.
- Must be in an accountability relationship.
